- (a) The legal documents for Henllys Way play park are now available. It's interesting to note that there is a requirement for a £6k deposit before the auction if an individual is proposing to bid.
- (b) I am attending the Mynydd Maen Wind Farm meeting on the 24th April. The pre-application consultation period ended on the 15th March. The April meeting is to discuss the response's received. To note the visual effects of the wind farm have significant impact on 14 viewpoints, including a couple in and around Cwmbran.
- (c) I shall also be attending the One Voice Wales eastern valleys meeting on the 30th April.
- (d) As you can see the Armed Forces Covenant is now on display in the meeting room for all to see. With thanks to Henllys Village Hall committee colleague who put up the covenant.
