The Henllys policy states that infill development within the village is restricted on the following grounds, scale of development and highway constraints.

To date no reply has been received.

2. To date there has been no response to the Stephen Vickers letter that we sent regarding his letter dated 15th May and the further questions we had about the Henllys Way park.
