Inspection of the play equipment by TCBC identified concerns with the safety of the roundabout & a trip hazard under the swings .

I have contacted a number of companies and have received 3 quotations.

- Company 1 £14,935.60 +VAT (replacement roundabout & safety surface only)
- Company 2 have prepared 3 quotations:
- 1. Repair and refurbishment of the existing roundabout. (£5500 + VAT)
- 2. Replacement swings. (£5250 + VAT)
- 3. Wetpour repair under the swings (£1580 + VAT) reduced price

Regarding the wetpour repairs, we would need to cut out the affected area to create a clean edge for the new wetpour to adhere correctly.

While we cannot guarantee the longevity of the repairs, they should resolve the immediate issue for a significant period of time. "

Company 3 (replacement roundabout & repair to wetpour under swings)

Supply and install standard carousel with bench - £6450.00
Site safety fencing and welfare - £200.00
Remove existing round-about - £800.00
Chase back rubber edges ready for safety surface over-lay £400.00
Rubber safety surface over-lay £ 1800.00
To patch swing base £300.00
Totals - £ 9950.00 + VAT

It was agreed to replace the roundabout & carry out the repair to the wetpour under the swings and Company 2 is to be given the opportunity to provide a revised quote
