12. Henllys Play Opportunities Report (TCBC in attendance)

Three questions were put to TCBC in advance of the meeting & the responses received are highlighted below .

- In relation to the half-term play schemes will all the children from Henllys be in the same place, and is that guaranteed. ?

We could guarantee a percentage of spaces for Henllys children in the same venue. We will also give them the choice of Cwmbran Stadium for the older children if they would prefer to go there.

- Could the play clubs stop using the Hall & instead use the meeting room & park from the 9th June until the end of term ?

Yes, I would not see it being a problem using the park as the weather will be nice until the end of term.

- Is it correct that C & L CC only make a contribution of £4k to the summer playscheme costs ?

Yes, this is correct. This amount has not changed in 25 years, and we are in the process of negotiating as it does not cover the costs of the offer in that community.

The responses received from TCBC were discussed & it was agreed that :

- The Tuesday play clubs will continue until the end of the school year (July 26)
- From Summer 26 the playscheme funded by the council will be outside Henllys
- From September 26 the Council will fund half term playschemes outside Henllys

TCBC were thanked for agreeing to move the play clubs to the meeting room & park from the 9th June .
