I hope you are all well & coping with the unusual weather we encountered over the summer months . Environmental challenges & their impact on the local community are one of the issues the Community Council is considering .

Since I became Chair of the Community Council its been a very busy time with a number of significant developments and the Community Council is planning to extend its activities to respond to a broader range of local needs.

Whilst continuing to fund local community groups, maintain the Dorallt park and fund the village fete, the community council is also considering :

- Improvements to Juniper Crescent Park
- The future of Henllys Way park
- Support for isolated & vulnerable residents
- Purchase of an additional defibrillator

In relation to the third point above , a pilot project commenced on the 29th September at the village hall . Afternoon tea is a way of engaging with residents on an informal basis to find out about their needs & concerns .

For this financial year we recognised the pressures on family budgets & kept the increase in council tax to 3%, an extra 87p a year for many residents.

Finally, the Community Council welcomes the views of residents, on what we do or what we should do.

# Community Council Budget :

The Community Council agreed its budget for 2023/24 & decided to increase the council tax by 3%, mindful of the financial pressures faced by many families.

Residents pay £29.83, for a band D property, 87p more than last year. Your council tax will be used to pay for :
